1. Outside edge roll, forward.
2. Outside edge roll, backward.
3. Single and double flat spins, cross foot and two foot whirls.
4. Inside edge roll, forward.
5. Inside edge roll, backward.
6. Figure eight on one foot forward, single and double circles.
7. Curved angles—threes, single, double and chain beginning on inside or outside edge.
8. Figure eight on one foot backward, single and double circles.
9. Cross roll forward—plain edges—eights, single and double circles.
10. Cross roll backward—plain edges—eights, single and double circles.
11. Ringlets and loops on inside and outside edges, single and in combination.
12. Change of edge roll forward—beginning on either outside or inside edge.
13. Change of edge roll backward—beginning on either outside or inside edge.
14. Curved angles—rocking and counter rocking turns for outside edge—O. E. & I. E.—I. E. forward and backward.
15. Curved angles—cross cuts or anvils on outside and inside edge, forward and backward.
16. Grapevines, single right and left, double forward and back, Philadelphia twist, single and double. Six other vines may be required and allowed such as Cupid Bow, Williams, Backward Anvil, Plumb, Pirouette-Philadelphia with toe, Pirouette-Philadelphia with heel, or any original vines in place of these.
17. Toe and heel movements embracing Pivot Circling, Toe Spins and movements on both toes.
18. Specialties embracing original and peculiar movements.

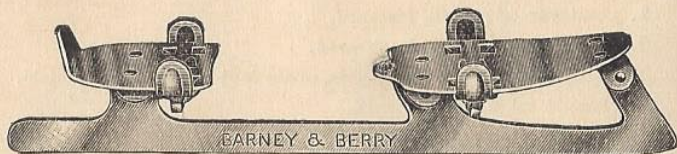

## HOCKEY RULES

### Which Govern the Game in the Principal Leagues of this Country and Canada

1. A team shall be composed of seven players.  
Positions: Goal, Point, Cover Point, Right Wing, Left Wing, Rover, Center.
2. Ice surface must be at least 150 feet long by 50 feet wide. Goals shall be 6 feet wide and 4 feet high, provided with nets and placed at least 8 feet from the edge of the ice.
3. The game shall be commenced and renewed by a face in the center of the rink. Definition of face: the puck shall be faced between the sticks of two opponents and the referee then calling "play."
4. Two twenty-minute halves with an intermission of ten minutes between will be allowed for matches. No stops of more than five minutes. A match will be decided by the team winning greatest number of goals during that time. In the case of a tie, after playing the specified two periods, ten minutes intermission will be allowed and play will then continue until one side secures a goal unless otherwise agreed between the captains before the match. In the event of no deciding goal the referee shall declare the match a draw. Goals shall be changed after each half.
5. Should the game be temporarily stopped by the infringement of any of the rules the captain of the opposite team may claim that puck be taken back and a face take place where it was last played from before such infringement occurred.
6. When a player hits the puck any one on the same side who at such moment of hitting is nearer the opponent's goal line is out of play and may not touch the puck himself nor in any way whatever prevent any other player from doing so until the puck has been played. A player must always be on his own side of the puck.
7. The puck may be stopped but not carried or knocked on by any part of the body, nor shall any player close his hand on or carry the puck to the ice in his hand. No player shall raise his stick above the shoulder, except in lifting the puck. Charging from behind, cross checking, tripping, collaring, kicking, clubbing or slashing shall not be allowed, and for any infringement of these rules the referee may rule the offending player off the ice for that match or for such portion of the actual playing time as he may see fit.
8. When the puck goes off the ice or a foul occurs behind the goals, it should be taken by the referee to five yards at right angles from the goal lines and there faced. When the puck goes off the ice at the sides, it should be taken by the referee to five yards at right angles from the boundary line and there faced.
9. The goal keeper must not, during play, lie, kneel, or sit on the ice, but must maintain a standing position.
10. Goals shall be scored when the puck shall have passed between the goal posts from in front below an imaginary line across the top of post.
11. Hockey sticks shall not be more than 3 inches wide at any point. The puck must be made of rubber, one inch thick all through, and three inches in diameter.

## HOCKEY RULES—Continued

12. After play has commenced, no player shall be allowed to leave the ice without permission of the referee. If a player who is injured has to leave the ice and is not able to continue within two minutes referee shall at once resume the game. If there be no substitute the captain of the opposing team must drop a man to equalize the team until absent player returns.
13. Any manager has the right to remove a player of his own team and put in a substitute, but any player removed by his manager during either half of the game shall not be allowed to return to the game during the half in which he was removed.
14. All disputes during the match shall be decided by the referee and he shall have full control of all players and officials, from the commencement to finish of matches, inclusive of stops, and his decisions shall be final.
15. Goal umpires shall decide all goals scored by the lifting of the hand above the head, and their decision shall be final.
16. Any claims or contentions regarding plays or interpretations of rules during matches shall be made by the captains only.
17. Special rules for cases of disorderly conduct, profane language, or where a player strikes with intention to injure.



### HOW TO CONSTRUCT AN INEXPENSIVE PRIVATE RINK

Select a level piece of sod ground, say 20 x 40 feet, and build a clay loam dike around the border 12 inches high by 12 inches wide on the top with sloping sides, thus:—

Where the goal is sandy, or the turf will not hold water, cover the bottom surface with about four inches of clay, to make everything water tight.

Never allow water to stand in it and if built early in the Fall, provide an outlet to carry off water that may accumulate from the Fall rains.

Everything being in readiness, when the thermometer falls 8 degrees below freezing, connect the garden hose with the sill cock, use the fine rose nozzle, and play the stream up in the air so as to have it come down in the form of a fine mist, and freeze on striking the ground, as no water must be allowed to stand in puddles nor run on striking the surface at any time, as it will make shelly ice.

Skating may be commenced on one inch of ice on the first night after spraying.

Continue to spray every cold night until the ice is six inches thick.

Snow must not be allowed to remain on the ice after a storm, as it injures the ice for skating if not promptly removed.

A rink of this size will accommodate twelve persons, may be constructed without harm to the lawn, and is perfectly safe; affording one of the most pleasant and health-giving amusements for both sexes and all ages.

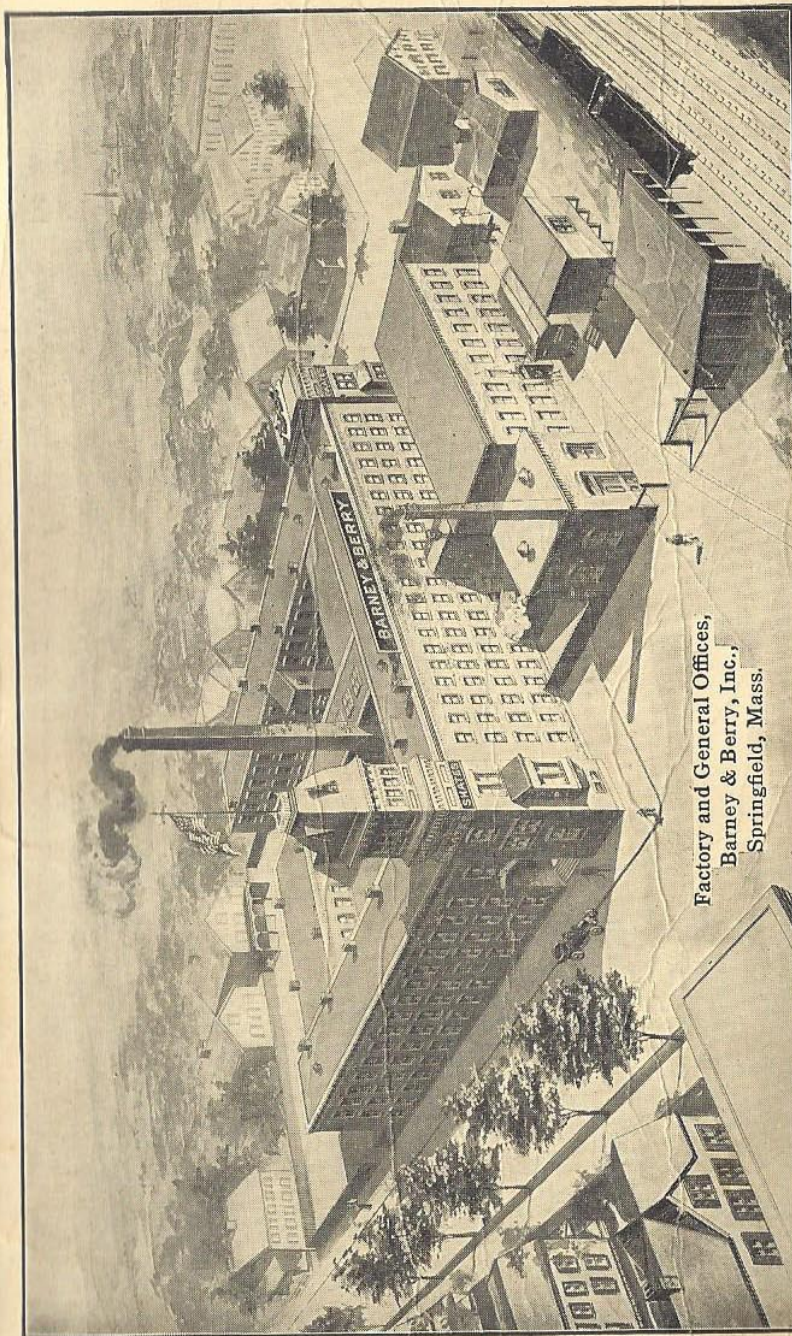
